What do we do?

The New Road Nursery Parent Group brings together parents who share a common interest in enhancing their child's nursery care by helping to provide opportunities such as outings, activities and new nursery equipment. This in turn builds strong links between nursery and parents.

We also discuss updates within the nursery, acting as a sounding board for new ideas and sharing feedback such as questionnaire results.

There is also a social element to the parent group. It is lovely to meet other parents, chat and share information about the latest things our children are doing (good and bad!). We sometimes go out for a drink or a meal as a group and many lasting friendships have been formed through the parent group.

Events & Activities

We organise a few events each year, from social events and skills workshops to fundraising for nursery projects or outings. Some examples of what we have achieved include family fun days, seasonal events, quiz nights, pamper evening, first aid course and a parenting course.

When do the meetings take place?

We meet once every 2 months at the nursery. Our meetings are friendly and informal but very productive. Sometimes we also get together prior to an event we are organising, just to finish off any last minute tasks, for example labelling raffle prizes, filling goody bags etc. Meetings are held on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday evenings and dates are set in advance for the whole year.
